



1. The purpose of this amendment is to:
 - a. Identify SFY 2013 GIA Administration funds as two line items.
 - b. Decrease SFY 2013 SAPT (Treatment) GIA funds.
2. Funding source amounts are indicated on the Award and Revenues page, Exhibit A, which replaces the previous one.
3. The Maximum consideration for the entire contract is decreased by \$1,015.00 to 720,634.46.
