The issue before the Board is the assessed value of land/improvements.


A hearing was held on June 18, 2013. Those present: Chairman Ann Shaw, Reta Hutchinson, Jennifer Hoyt, Clerk Debbie Myers, Appraiser Anthony Clayton. Appellant was not present.

Appraiser Anthony Clayton said Suncadia as a Master Planned Resort has a great deal of open space property, approximately 6,000 acres. He went over the exhibits and maps provided by the Assessor's office and the future developable property. He also discussed the range of current and future prices on lots to be developed and the differences location to the village and utilities may make.


Pursuant to RCW 84.40.0301, the value placed on the property by the assessor is presumed to be correct, and can only be overcome by clear cogent and convincing evidence. This means the appellant is required to provide enough information to convince this Board that it is highly probable the assessed value is incorrect.

The appellant was not present and there was no supporting documentation submitted by the appellant or their representative. The Board of Equalization voted 3-0 to sustain the Assessor's value.
