The issue before the Board is the assessed value of land/improvements.


A hearing was held on June 25, 2013. Those present: Chairman Ann Shaw, Reta Hutchinson, Jennifer Hoyt, Clerk Debbie Myers, Appraiser Anthony Clayton. Appellant was not present.

Appraiser Anthony Clayton said this group is commercial property. Petitions 255 & 256 are the services unit. There is 223 residential condominium units with conference space and restaurant. Petitions 520-526 are the buildings that house the Village, spa, fitness center and the ice skating rink. Petitions 309 and 311 have been sold and are bullfrog parcels. He said they used the cost approach to value the properties and that the acreage was valued at \$4,000 an acre.


Pursuant to RCW 84.40.0301, the value placed on the property by the assessor is presumed to be correct, and can only be overcome by clear cogent and convincing evidence. This means the appellant is required to provide enough information to convince this Board that it is highly probable the assessed value is incorrect.

The appellant was not present and there was no supporting documentation submitted by the appellant or their representative. The Board of Equalization voted 3-0 to sustain the Assessor's value.
