SPECIAL MEETING GRIEVANCE STEP TWO ASSESSORS

At 3:00 P.m. Chairman McClain asked Don Boxford whether they wished to have the meeting in the open or in an Executive Session. When Mr. Boxford said he wished for an Executive Session, Chairman McClain announced at 3:05 p.m. the Board would go into Executive Session for thirty minutes to evaluate the qualifications of an applicant for public employment or to review the performance of a public employee. However, subject to RCW 42.30.140 (4), discussion by a governing body of salaries, wages, and other conditions of employment to be generally applied within the agency shall occur in a meeting open to the public, and when a governing body elects to take final action hiring, setting the salary of an individual employee or class of employees, or discharging or disciplining an employee, that action shall be taken in a meeting open to the public. He anticipated no action.

At 3:35 p.m. the Board reconvened out of Executive Session.
