UPDATE BOCC/ DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS COMMISSIONERS

He stated that the project would be managed by the Conservation District and they are currently seeking funding assistance.

Chairman Jewell suggested contributing \$5,000.00 and felt it was a good project.

Commissioner O'Brien stated he thought the estimate was high, and that there are local businesses that could produce a good quality product for less. He stated that he would consider \$2,500.00 of the \$10,000.00 needed.

Commissioner Osiadacz felt it is a good project but asked that Chairman Jewell find out what funding has been obtained so far and that perhaps the County could contribute the difference.

Chairman Jewell was directed to report back when he obtained the information requested.
