Department updates

Administrator update

Tristen Lamb stepped to the microphone. Ms. Lamb updated the board on the following items:

- Current hepatitis A outbreak in the state
- Contracts and amendments



- Three current contracts in the works, notably Central Washington University update their contract with KCPHD to span three years, as well as an increased monetary cap.
- Ms. Lamb had nominated Amy Fuller, KCPHD Assessment Coordinator, for the Washington State Public Health Association (WSPHA) Public Health Excellence Award, for which she was selected. She will be formally acknowledged at the WSPHA conference in October.

Department Updates

- Staff of the Onsite Sewage program held a stakeholder meeting to inform policy updates.
- Staff from environmental health, health promotion, and assessment collaborated on a grant application from Department of Ecology, requesting funds for food waste reduction education.
- Free immunization clinics for Ellensburg, Kittitas, and Cle Elum/Roslyn school districts are being held within the next two weeks.
- Health Promotion staff held a meeting with stakeholders regarding childhood injury prevention, and gaps were identified with the safe kids program. They are working towards solutions for these gaps.
- There is currently only one outstanding health order, which will be going to abatement process. Ms. Lamb also reviewed a tentative meeting schedule with the board for the rest of 2019 Board of Health meetings as well as Board of County Commissioner's study sessions.

Ms. Lamb refreshed the board on the difference between stable and unstable funding, as well as explained that she hopes to use the gantt as a tool for both KCPHD and the board to plan future funding.

Budget Amendment

Tristen Lamb briefly updated the board on an upcoming budget amendment she is submitting through the auditor's office. The update includes more realistic numbers based on how the year is going, and based on budget numbers that are not able to be finalized until after the initial budget is approved.
