## 3. 2025 Preliminary Budget Meeting with Criminal Justice Public Safety (CJPS)

Mr. Carlson discussed the 2025 Budget. Advising the group of the \$10MM problem, with a three year runway. Pending 2025 budget requests include Projects, Capital and Personnel. 3/10<sup>th</sup> Criminal Justice Sales Tax Fund Balance is \$5MM. Mr. Carlson discussed the Criminal Justice Public Safety Budget focusing on the breakdown of expenses and revenues. Each of the CJPS departments 2025 budget information was presented and compared back to the group and County as a whole. It was noted that Public Defense department will start recieving income from the City of Ellensburg. The request for new postitions will be determined after the Superior Court of Washington has a final ruling on case loads requirements.
