DISCUSSION EXEMPT PTO/UPDATE - DIRECTION COMMISSIONERS

Bryan Elliott, Auditor, reviewed options for the Board to consider from a Staff Report. He asked the Board how they would like to proceed, in light of their previous decision (lump sum deposit of leave for employees going from exempt to non-exempt) being determined a gift of public funds. The Board opted to go with decision #1 for employees who are being reclassified to non-exempt will receive the



non-exempt accrual rate in 2025. This will reduce the employee's PTO accrual rate by 4 hours per month. The employee will become eligible for overtime and comp. time leave, which are benefits that can make up for the reduced PTO accrual rates.
