Vice-Chairman Wright gave an update on the FMSIB Meeting he attended in Wenatchee the week prior and an update on the BEAD Award.


Chairman Osiadacz gave an update on the meeting she had with City of Cle Elum regarding the LTAC Large Scale Capital Grants ask.
