SNOQUALMIE PASS COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN UPDATE

Cameron Curtis briefed the Board of County Commissioners on the progress made utilizing the Safe Streets and Roads for All funding. Cameron Curtis stated that engagement with the community and stakeholders' group have generated a lot of feedback and with the data collected there have been potential projects identified to improve road safety. Cameron Curtis stated that the consultant will have material prepared to present to the public for comment.

6-YEAR TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE

Cameron Curtis briefed the Board of County Commissioners on the upcoming 6-year plan and stated that Public Works will be seeking online engagement for 3-weeks. Cameron Curtis identified that this year's plan looks different from previous years because the list identifies the projects that have secured funding and another identifies Capital Improvement needs if funds come available.
