**Direct Staff regarding HopeSource contract amendment request**

Chelsey Loeffers noted that John Raymond, HopeSource, had withdrawn the request to reallocate funds for the Behavioral Health Bridge and Senior Support and Advocacy Programs until HopeSource works out the invoicing process. At this time HopeSource will continue to invoice as they have been.

**HopeSource Invoicing Discussion**

The group discussed invoicing and how it could change in the future now that HopeSource has transitioned to a Whole Person Care model and how to account for funds spent. The county will meet with HopeSource in January to discuss what is needed and remind them of the county audit in 2026. Commissioner Wright requested public health to set up a meeting in January with staff to continue discussions.
