Drinking Water	• Prior to conditional use approval the Public Health Department will need to see proof of City Utility connection. A utility agreement along with water permits will need to be submitted to show utility connection. • If connecting to utilities becomes unfeasible, then a Group B well will need to be used for the intended project.
Wastewater	• Prior to conditional use approval the Public Health Department will need to see proof of City Utility connection. A utility agreement along with sewer permits will need to be submitted to show utility connection. • If connecting to utilities becomes unfeasible, then an approved septic system designed by a licensed OSS designer will need to be submitted for approval for intended project.
