We've reviewed the proposed project against State and Tribal sensitivity maps; given the existing plan for the culvert removal to be monitored by a cultural resource specialist and the inclusion of an IDP, the CTCR has no major concerns for the project's potential to impact resources of historic, religious, or cultural significance. 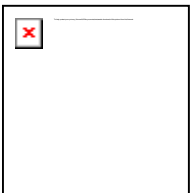

ENGINEERING	Except as exempted in KCC 14.05.060, no grading or filling upon a site involving more than one hundred (100) cubic yards shall be performed without a grading permit from the County Engineer or Public Works designee (KCC 14.05.050). An application for grading in excess of five hundred (500) cubic yards shall be accompanied by an engineered grading plan (KCC 14.05.080). (CBP)
FLOOD	A portion of parcel #129234 is mapped within the FEMA identified special flood hazard area. A flood permit is not required for the project since the culvert to be removed is not within the regulatory floodplain boundary. (SC)
WATER MITIGATION/ METERING	No comments. (SC)
AIRPORT	No comments. (RC)
