ENGINEERING	Except as exempted in KCC 14.05.060, no grading or filling upon a site involving more than one hundred (100) cubic yards shall be performed without a grading permit from the County Engineer or Public Works designee (KCC 14.05.050). An application for grading in excess of five hundred (500) cubic yards shall be accompanied by an engineered grading plan (KCC 14.05.080). (CBP)
FLOOD	A portion of parcel # 307636 is within the FEMA identified special flood hazard area. The location of the vault toilet is not within the mapped regulatory floodplain. A floodplain development permit is not required for the project. (SC)

We have completed our review of the SX-26-00015 project. This response is on behalf of the interim Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO), Amelia Stanger.

While the proposed project falls outside of what the Colville Business Council has delineated as the traditional territory of the tribes which compose the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, it does fall within areas of usual and accustomed use. We recognize that there may be other interested parties, particularly tribal partners, who also have concern or interest for the potential effects of this undertaking on historic, cultural, or religious resources. We recommend having an inadvertent discovery plan in place for any ground disturbing activities.
