The Snoqualmie Tribe [Tribe] is a federally recognized sovereign Indian Tribe. We were signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliott of 1855; we reserved certain rights and privileges and ceded certain lands to the United States. As a signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliot, the Tribe specifically reserved among other things, the right to fish at usual and accustomed areas and the “privilege of hunting and gathering roots and berries on open and unclaimed lands” off-reservation throughout the modern-day state of Washington.

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment. Based on the information provided and our understanding of the project and its APE we have no substantive comments to offer at this time. However, please be aware that if the scope of the project or the parameters for defining the APE change we reserve the right to modify our current position.

This consult is in reference to SP-24-00007 Davenport. This undertaking involves no ground disturbance at this time but is likely in preparation for it.

This undertaking is located within the CCT Traditional Territories. We request any undertakings, particularly those involving ground disturbing activities, to have an IDP in place prior to implementation.

The proposed project lies within the traditional territories of the Moses-Columbia Tribe, 1 of the 12 constituent tribes of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation (CTCR), which is governed by the Colville Business Council (CBC). The CBC has delegated to the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) the responsibility of representing the CTCR with regard to cultural resources management issues throughout the traditional territories of all of the constituent tribes under Resolution 1996-29. This area includes parts of eastern Washington, northeastern Oregon, the Palus territory in Idaho, and south-central British Columbia.

There are known cultural resources of pre contact and historic significance nearby and this particular plat is considered High to Very High Risk for an inadvertent discovery according to the DAHP predictive model.

Additionally, there are four known TCPs nearby the proposed plat division. TCPs are places important to the CTCR for the preservation and continuation of the community's traditional lifestyle. TCPs can be, but are not limited to, religious areas, sacred areas, resource gathering areas (plant, animal, fish, and mineral), places associated with stories and legends, archaeological and ethnographic sites, habitation sites, camp sites, pictograph and petroglyph locations, special use sites, trails, and places with Indian names. For native people, natural resources are cultural resources. Traditional cultural plant resources are not only cherished for fiber, food, medicine, and building material, but are an intrinsic aspect of indigenous sovereignty; these plants link the people of the present to the people of the past.

CCT requests a cultural resource survey and that during implementation that there be an inadvertent discovery plan or (IDP) in place to ensure compliance with all Section 106 and relevant cultural resource laws both federally and to the state of Washington.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Notice of Application for the **Davenport Short Plat**. We have reviewed the application and have the following comment.

**Water Resources Program:**

In Washington State, prospective water users must obtain authorization from the Department of Ecology before diverting surface water or withdrawing ground water, with one exception. Ground water withdrawals for a project up to 5,000 gallons per day used for single or group domestic supply, up to 5,000 gallons per day used for industrial purposes, stock watering, and for the irrigation of up to one-half acre of non-commercial lawn and garden are exempt from the permitting process. Water use under the RCW 90.44.050 exemption establishes a water right that is subject to the same privileges, restrictions, laws and regulations as a water right permit or certificate obtained directly from Ecology.

I have reviewed the Short Pat and associated documents for the listed project and/or construction for Kittitas County Fire District 2 (KVFR). The Fire District has no code enforcement authority, so my input is from a fire department response and operational basis.

### Comments:

- Fire apparatus access roads exceeding 150' shall be provided with a temporary or permanent turnaround meeting the requirement 2021 IFC Appendix D.
- Fire apparatus access roads shall not exceed 10% in grade. This is especially critical in our valley's climate.
- The IFC Appendix D requires the road be a minimum of 20' wide and capable of supporting an imposed load of at least 75,000 lbs.
- Road turning radius required under IFC Appendix D are a minimum of 23' inside and 45' outside.
- Any future construction on the parcels shall be required to meet all water fire flow requirements as adopted by Kittitas County under WUI code and International Fire code.
