I live at 41493 Kittitas Highway with my wife and Aunt, and we've always enjoyed being part of this community. As you move forward with the PUD relocation project, I wanted to share a few thoughts and concerns about our property to work together toward the best possible outcome.

Right next to your planned drain field area on our property is a collection pond that helps manage flooding from the surrounding fields—especially during the planting season, when the land becomes waterlogged. If this isn't already on your radar, I'd encourage you to consider it in your planning, as it's been essential in keeping our property and the neighboring fields protected.

Another area to be mindful of is where your office building is planned to sit. The meeting point of our lots, including our driveway, regularly floods when the farmland is irrigated. Our driveway has sometimes been underwater for over a month. Last year, when your land wasn't farmed, we noticed less flooding, but it still occurred. My hope is that your project can help address or at least not worsen these ongoing issues.

I'm especially concerned that changes to your property—like filling in building foundations—might inadvertently divert even more water toward our driveway or increase drainage challenges for all of us on this side. I share these details not just for our own peace of mind, but because I believe we all want to be good neighbors and find solutions together.

I truly appreciate the open, thoughtful conversations we've had so far. While I won't be in town for the meeting this week, I'm always happy to connect by phone or stop by in a couple of weeks. Thank you for listening and for taking our concerns into account.
