#### NOTICE OF SEPA ACTION AND DECISION Hyak PSERN Conditional Use Permit ACU-18-00003

NOTICE IS HERBY given that pursuant to 43.21C RCW, Kittitas County Community Development Services did on November 28, 2018 make a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for and approved the Hyak PSERN Administrative Conditional Use Permit (ACU-18-00003). This proposal is located on Parcel #028335, located on State Road 906 in Snoqualmie Pass, in Kittitas County, bearing Assessor's Map Number 22-11-15040-0005. Bryson Burghardt, agent for Washington Department of Transportation is proposing the extension of an existing 60 foot Communication Tower to 90 feet for expanded emergency communication services.
