SUBJECT: Schnebly Intervening Ownership SG-12-00005

Our department has reviewed the Request for Parcel Segregation Application and finds that it meets current Kittitas County Road Standards.

Our department recommends Final Approval with the following conditions:

- a. An approved Access Permit shall be required from the Kittitas County Department of Public Works prior to creating any new driveway access or performing any work within the County Road Right of Way.
- b. Maintenance of driveway approaches shall be the responsibility of the owner whose property they serve. The County will not maintain accesses.
- c. Any further subdivision or lots to be served by proposed access may result in further access requirements. See Kittitas County Road Standards.
- d. Evidence of existing access and/or evidence of access to be created should be confirmed prior to sale of property.
- e. Access is not guaranteed to any existing or created parcel on this application.

In addition to the above-mentioned conditions, all applicable Kittitas County Road Standards apply to this proposal. Please let me know if you have any questions or need further information.

Ruby Street, Suite 2 Ellensburg, WA 98926 Schnebly (SG-12-00005) Re: Dear Mr. Watson: After conducting a review of the above named project, I have the following comments: Ensure that the segregation does not infringe upon existing structures, to include propane tanks, etc. Creation of any additional roads or access must comply with the International Fire Code. If access to the property is across the canal, any new bridge shall be permitted through this office and shall be constructed to meet the minimum requirements of 75,000 lbs live load. An existing bridge shall be certified by an engineer that it meets those requirements. All future development must comply with the International Fire Code. Jeff – I have reviewed the Schnebly Intervening Ownership application to divide property at 1063 Lester Road into two tax parcels. At this point, creating two tax parcels does not impact KVFR. However, if the property is developed, the following fire code issues will need to be addressed:

1. Access will need to be compliant with the current IFC Appendix D.

- 2. Access to fire suppression water will need to be addressed that matches the proposed development.
- 3. Addressing will need to be visible from both directions of travel for both parcels.
- 4. It is recommended that, if structures are to be built, fire alarm and sprinkler systems be considered to mitigate extended response times for fire suppression resources.
