## Lindsey,

The SEPA checklist for the Anderson Hay rezone project claims that there is no natural watercourse on the subject property. That is incorrect. The property includes a small perennial watercourse, which some refer to as "spring creek" and associated wetlands. This wetland/watercourse joins the Bull Canal adjacent to Umptanum Road and the collective flow of both watercourses then flows into Wilson Creek. In the past I have found fish in the spring creek when the water quality is good. From its confluence with Bull Canal until it flows into Wilson Creek, many species of fish are present including salmon and steelhead, and the rearing of juvenile spring chinook, coho and rainbow trout/steelhead is an important concern. For your reference, I have marked the watercourse/wetland on the attached PowerPoint slides.

This proposal is likely to have significant adverse environmental impacts unless mitigation measures are incorporated in the proposal. At a minimum the following measures should be required.

This creek location should be recorded on the maps and site plans. The associated wetland should be delineated and an appropriate critical area buffer and structural setback should be assigned for this watercourse/wetland.

All fill necessary for the proposed development should be identified in the SEPA checklist and site plans. Fill should be limited to areas outside of the stream and wetland Critical Area buffers.

All stormwater runoff from this site should be treated and disposed of in a manner consistent with the guidance of Ecology's Stormwater Manual.

The county's link to the site plan and other documents does not seem to be working for outside users, which is problematic for reviewers of this project. See the screenshot below of the error message below.
