

Location:	The project is located on Anderson Road, Ellensburg, WA, in a portion of Section 11, T17N, R18E, WM in Kittitas County. Assessor's map numbers 17-18-11000-0006, -0010, -0017, -0024, -0025, and -0026.
Serving Roadway:	Anderson Road
Capacity Allocation	This proposal is not expected to cause an increase in trip generation. Any future project specific applications will be reviewed separate from this project for concurrency
Kittitas County Department of Public Works has determined there will not be a significant impact to the County roads serving this project and there is sufficient capacity on the serving roadways for the additional traffic to be generated by this project. No mitigation will be required. This decision was made after review of the completed transportation concurrency management application which is on file with Public Works.
