Please accept my comments on the CU-12-00002 Canyon River Ranch CUP application. While I strongly believe this project is exactly the type of attraction that can provide an excellent economic driver for Kittitas County, using the natural beauty the Yakima River provides, there are several flaws in the current application. Fortunately, these problems can easily be remedied by purchasing and retiring upstream senior water rights.

While both issues involve water use, one falls under the Department of Ecology and other under the Department of Health. I incorporate here the DOE response of April 29, 2013 by Sage Park, Operations and Permitting Unit Supervisor, Water Resources Program / CRO. This references water right in the Yakima Basin and the 2011 USGS Study. There is currently no senior water right associated with this facility.

Regarding the Department of Health, I have included a link for the DOH Sentry Program Water System ID 72990. This has current information on the hookups allowed for this system. It shows they have recently been approved to increase the number of hook-ups from 14 to 18. However, the application clearly shows a total of 22 cabins <u>plus</u> the lodge and miscellaneous outbuildings. The math does not add up.

Based on the existing structures, I believe the current use must exceed the amount of water allowed under the permit-exempt well exception, especially with the vineyards that have been added and the grand lodge, both in terms of instantaneous and annual usage. It is important to remember that even if this permit-exempt well is within the 5,000 gal/day, their beneficial use includes the amount historically used not an automatic 5,000 gal. Any expansion of an existing well is considered a new use by Ecology. However, I believe this is not presently a compliant well and the addition of more cabins will only exacerbate the problem. This well is a mere 32 feet deep (see the DOH Sentry program).

However, with their main-stem location, mitigation water should be easily obtained and a minimal investment relative to the impressive project the applicants are undertaking. I should think that the upscale market they are targeting would appreciate patronizing a resort in the Yakima River Canyon that is known to be sustainable and friendly to the very environment they are traveling to enjoy.
