The Department of Public Works has reviewed the permit for the NMF Enterprises Conditional Use Permit and has the following comments:

- A. <u>Transportation Concurrency</u>: A Determination of Concurrency Finding has been issued for this project under number TC-14-00002. No mitigation is required of this project.
- B. <u>Site Access</u>: The driveway must be constructed to commercial standards, as shown in the WSDOT Design Manual Exhibit 1340-2.
- C. <u>Access Permit</u>: An approved access permit shall be required from the Department of Public Works prior to alteration of the existing access. No new accesses will be allowed.
- D. Addressing: Contact the Kittitas County Rural Addressing Coordinator at (509) 962-7523 to obtain addresses prior to obtaining a building permit. A parcel cannot receive a building permit or utilities until such parcel is identified with a 911 address.
