I'd recommend 36"W x 48"H for the signs to be seen from the middle of a river along with the warning sign at the top of the ramp. For comparison this is the size of a speed limit sign on a state highway (interstate speed limit signs are 48"W x 60"H). For the Attention sign the recommendation is 24"W x 36"H.

I'm told by DOT rectangle signs are more noticeable than square....who knew☺ JJH

The top two signs need to be legible from the middle of the Yakima River while bobbing in an inner tube . The Warning sign needs to be legible at the top of the boat ramp. These three I'm thinking should be 3'x3'. The Attention sign, I'm thinking 2'x2'. How's that sound? Is that big enough?
