KVFR has the following input:

- Access will need to meet current IFC Appendix D, county road standards and any WUI access requirements.
- If any of the event spaces are secured or if there is a locked access gate, we will require Knox box located as designated by KVFR.
- The tent will need to be stamped for flame resistive rating.
- The Phase 2 permanent structure (atrium/greenhouse) will likely exceed threshold for building code to require sprinkler system.
- WUI code risk assessment and compliance to meet applicable requirements. Requirements to maintain vegetation in parking areas to no create fire risk due to vehicle component contact.
- Addressing / site plan unsure if buildings will be independently addressed? Regardless, emergency responders will need to be able to identify access points via clear addressing and/or site maps.

The conditional use permit application is something we do not completely understand in terms of code compliance. Is this is a one-time use to determine venue layout and feasibility or will this be used more than once in this configuration? How does the Phase 2 work with a conditional use permit? What I am getting at is the potential for lack of complete code compliance under the umbrella of conditional use. If that is not a valid concern, you can disregard this portion of the email.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment during the optional determination of nonsignificance process for the Brightside Event Center, proposed by Heidi Bright. We have reviewed the documents and have the following comments.

WATER QUALITY

The proposed project is located within the program areas of two Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) programs. These TMDL programs address water quality limitations for suspended sediment, turbidity, pesticides and fecal coliform bacteria. Irrigation water (in canals, ditches, and other conveyances) is classified as a water of the state; this project will need to protect these waters from further degradation. Project planning, development, and use of the site needs to include water quality protection. Please contact Jane Creech (jton461@ecy.wa.gov, 509-454-7860) if you have questions about these TMDL programs.

WATER RESOURCES

The checklist noted that the proponent is working to get Group A Water System approval, however, there were no water rights specific to the parcel/address provided. Group A water use typically does not fall under permit exempt limits. In Washington State, prospective water users must obtain authorization from the Department of Ecology before diverting surface water or withdrawing ground water, with one exception. Ground water withdrawals of up to 5,000 gallons per day used for single or group domestic supply, industrial purposes, stock watering or for the irrigation of up to one-half acre of lawn and garden are exempt from the permitting process.

If the water is from a permitted source such as city water, water association, or an irrigation or reclamation district, then the water purveyor is responsible for ensuring that the proposed use(s)

are within the limitations of its water rights. If the proposal's actions are different than the existing water right (source, purpose, the place of use, or period of use), then it is subject to approval from the Department of Ecology pursuant to Sections 90.03.380 RCW and 90.44.100 RCW.

The Department of Public Works has reviewed the permit for the Brightside Event Center Conditional Use Permit and has the following comments:

Engineering:

- 1. It appears that the proposal creates greater than 5,000 square feet of new impervious area. A stormwater plan meeting the requirements of the <u>Stormwater Management Manual for Eastern Washington</u>, current edition; is required.
- 2. A transportation concurrency application is required for the proposal.
- 3. No parking in County Right of Way is allowed associated with any activity of the conditional use.
- 4. A grading permit is required if more than 100 cubic yards of material are excavated from the site or imported onto the site.
- 5. The new proposed access shall meet all requirements of Kittitas County Code Title 12.

Planning:

- 6. Access Roads will need to meet Kittitas County Code Chapter 12 and International Fire Code appendix D requirements.
- 7. Fire Apparatus Turn Around to be constructed to International Fire code Appendix D Hammerhead requirements at the location where it terminates at an outbuilding as approved by the Fire Marshal, so long as no parking anywhere on or along the driveway in and the drive to the right and left takes place.
- 8. No event parking will be allowed on the County Right of Way.
