Kittitas PUD Bettas Road Substation Expansion

Project Narrative

The Kittitas PUD Bettas Road Substation Expansion project is a proposed extension to an existing electrical substation, located 4,000sf southeast of the intersection of Hayward Rd and Bettas Rd, to better serve the electrical load growth and improve the service reliability in the surrounding area. The total site area of the project is 3.58 acres with 3.22 acres of disturbance during construction activity. No water system or sewage system is proposed as a part of this project. A 335sf control building is a part of the proposed expansion, as well as major substation equipment structures.
