Dear Mr. Torrance-Smith,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Hayford Well Communications Tower project. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) is familiar with the project area, and we've reviewed the application materials available on file.

The application materials available for review do not discuss the overall area of disturbance for this project and do not address the potential impacts to shrubsteppe habitat with construction of this project. We request that a complete site plan be provided that includes all temporary and permanent disturbance so all potential impacts to shrubsteppe habitat can be reviewed and properly mitigated for, consistent with the County's critical areas ordinance.

Additionally, WDFW recommends the proponent follow the <u>USFWS Recommended Best</u> <u>Practices for Communication Tower Design, Siting, Construction, Operation, Maintenance and</u> <u>Decommissioning</u> to minimize impacts to birds throughout the life of the project.

We would be pleased to conduct a site visit with the project proponents and CDS staff to evaluate the potential habitat impacts and to review any subsequent mitigation plans and/or Habitat Management Plans that may be necessary based on critical areas present on the site.
