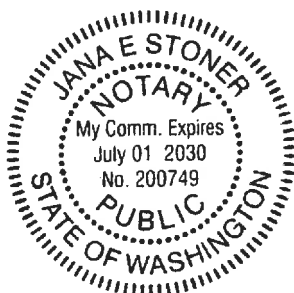

KITTITAS COUNTY – Notice of Decision Jentges Conditional Use Permit (CU-26-00001)

Pursuant to RCW 36.70B.130 and KCC 15A.06, notice is hereby given that on June 22, 2026, the Kittitas County Hearings Examiner approved the Jentges Conditional Use Permit (CU-26-00001). The proposed project is a Small-Scale Event Facility specializing in agricultural-based therapy and wellness services. The project will utilize built residential, non-residential, and agricultural structures that exist on-site. The subject parcels are in Agriculture-20 zoning with a Rural-Working land use designation. The proposed project is located at 730 Alford Rd., in a portion of the NW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Sec. 7, T. 18, R. 19, bearing Assessor's Map# 18-19-07000-0020 & 18-19-07000-0010 in Kittitas County. Affected property owners may request a change in valuation for property tax purposes notwithstanding any program of revaluation.

Issuance of this land use decision may be appealed by parties with standing, by filing a land use petition (LUPA) in Superior Court and serving said petition on all required parties pursuant to RCW 36.70C and KCC 15A.08, within twenty-one days of the publishing of the land use decision. **The last day to file a LUPA is July 17, 2026.**
