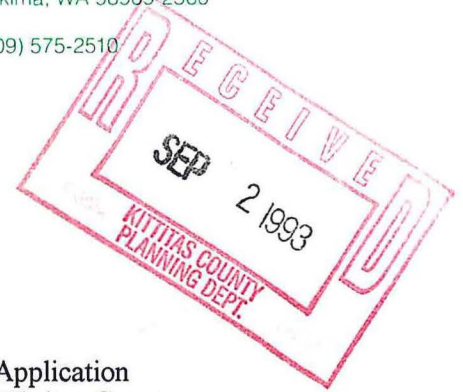

SUBJECT: Conditional Use Permit Application
Quarry Site, QS-S-234, Kittitas County
SR 82, MP 17.3 Vic.

The Washington State Department of Transportation proposes to utilize the existing subject quarry site for the mining, production and processing, and stockpiling of mineral aggregates for roadway pavements on an upcoming highway rehabilitation project. This work requires that temporary crushers and asphalt and concrete plants be placed and set up in the site. As indicated in your SEPA comments and Kittitas County Zoning Code, Forest and Range, chapter 17.56; a conditional use permit is necessary for the proposed temporary asphalt plant. You also indicated that an administrative determination may be made that would also allow a temporary concrete plant as a "use not listed, yet nearly identical to a permitted use."

→ The state Attorney Generals Office has determined that the Department, as a state agency, is exempt from local ordinances and permits. However, in order to promote a good working relationship with Kittitas County, we are applying for a county conditional use permit. We would also request an administrative determination to also allow a temporary concrete plant. Attached are the permit application, \$150.00 permit fee, and other supporting information.
