Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Kittitas County Fire District #2 Public Facility PF-10-00004.

Adequate Potable Water Supply Statement:

The applicant will need to develop and have a public water system design approved for the proposed project prior to building permit issuance. The public water system will either be a group A or group B water system depending on the intended occupancy. The applicant should contact the Kittitas County Health Department **ASAP**, so that we may assist the applicant through the lengthy application process. It is not uncommon that the water system approval process may take a couple of months to complete. To avoid delays in the project construction or loss of funding I highly encourage that the applicant begin the water system approval process immediately.

Septic Availability Statement:

Prior to building permit issuance the applicant will need to have an approved septic permit. The applicant should begin this process by contacting a licensed septic designer and performing a site evaluation, and then the applicant may proceed to the design approval stage. Installation of the on-site sewage system will need to occur prior to certificate of occupancy approval.
