Kittitas County Fire District No. 7 Station 72 Housing Project

Kittitas County Fire District No. 7 is looking to put an 1813 square foot, 4 bedroom manufactured home on 1.94 acre parcel owned by the district next to the current station 72 at 5461 Airport Road, Cle Elum, WA 98922. This structure will be a stand-alone housing structure with its own private individual well and OSS system. This structure will not be assessable to the public in any way. The goal of this project is to have housing for our paid full-time firefighters on the more eastern and central area of our fire district to better the safety of our constituents. This structure will have a residential sprinkler system installed along with required defensible space for wildland fire safety.

Will the proposed Public Facilities Permit be detrimental to public health, safety, and general welfare?

No, it will not have any effect on public health or general welfare and could possibly increase public safety.

Will the proposed Public Facilities Permit be injurious to the property or improvements adjacent to, and in the vicinity of, the site upon which the proposed use is to be located?

No, as stated before the structure will be a residential home, same as the surrounding area.
