NOTICE IS HEREBY given that pursuant to WAC 197-11-340, Kittias County Community Development Services did on July 30, 2013 issue a Final Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance (MDNS) on a project action from Teresa Zentz for a Rezone and associated Short Plat.
