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Hello,

This compliance review is in response to the application for Shoreline Exemption Permitting, **SX-25-00003 Widmann**, for the construction of a small 10' x 7.5' personal-use shed.

Please be advised that the proposed undertaking lies within the traditional territories of the Wenatchi Tribe, 1 of the 12 constituent tribes of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation (also known as the Colville Confederated Tribes or CCT), which is governed by the Colville Business Council (CBC). The CBC has delegated to the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) the responsibility of representing the CCT with regard to cultural resources management issues throughout the traditional territories of all the constituent tribes under Resolution 1996-29. In addition, the THPO has assumed the responsibilities of a state historic preservation office within the exterior boundaries of the Colville Reservation and associated parcels of trust land that lay outside the current reservation boundaries, as outlined in Section 101 (d) (2) of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA)

This is a ground disturbing activity in an area determined by DAHP to have a Very High probability for cultural resources to be present. The proposed undertaking has a small footprint, so CCT H/A requests that the proponent prepare and have on-hand an Inadvertent Discovery Plan (IDP) before construction.
