Good evening Zach,

We have completed our review of the SX-26-00008 Roe Shoreline Exemption Permit. This response is on behalf of the Interim Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO), Amelia Stanger.

The proposed project lies within the traditional territory of the šnp' əšqwáw' səxw (people in between) or Wenatchi, one of the 12 tribes which make up the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation (CTCR), which is governed by the Colville Business Council (CBC). The CBC has delegated to the THPO the responsibility of representing the CTCR with regard to cultural resources management issues throughout the traditional territories of all of the constituent tribes under Resolution 1996-29.

While the application provided does not include extensive information regarding the project and how it will be implemented, a cultural resource survey and report (1341896) of an approximately 50-acre area 0.09 miles north of the proposed project did not identify cultural resources. This survey was along a meandering tributary, as this proposed project is as well, and is unlikely to contain cultural resources. We do recommend having an inadvertent discovery plan (IDP) prepared in the event that cultural resources are identified during project implementation, but otherwise do not have concerns regarding the undertaking.
