Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed project on parcel(s) 961873 in Section 28 and 33, T. 20 N., Range 16 E., W.M.; Kittitas County.

Based on remote review of this parcel(s) it appears that some or all of the parcel(s) consist of forestland, and it will require a Forest Practices Application (FPA) from the DNR if merchantable timber is removed/harvested as part of the proposal and/or is being converted out of forest land (RCW 76.09 and WAC 222). The FPA would need to meet the requirements of the Forest Practices Act and its rules. It is our recommendation that the applicant meet with our local forest practices forester to discuss, they may call our Southeast Region office at (509) 925-8510 to schedule an appointment.

The Snoqualmie Tribe [Tribe] is a federally recognized sovereign Indian Tribe. We were signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliott of 1855; we reserved certain rights and privileges and ceded certain lands to the United States. As a signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliot, the Tribe specifically reserved among other things, the right to fish at usual and accustomed areas and the "privilege of hunting and gathering roots and berries on open and unclaimed lands" off-reservation throughout the modern-day state of Washington.

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment. Based on the information provided and our understanding of the project and its APE, we recommend an archeological review performed for this project. This is in an area the Snoqualmie Tribe considers culturally significant and has a moderate probability to have unknown archaeological deposits. We realize that though subdivisions do not cause ground disturbance, in almost all cases this process leads to development projects that will. If any archaeological work is performed, we request notification. An IDP should not be used in lieu of an archeological investigation. Cultural and archaeological resources are non-renewable and are best discovered prior to ground disturbance.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed short plat near Cle Elum. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) is familiar with this area and nearby critical areas that should be considered as part of this review and determination process. We offer the following comments for consideration to ensure all critical areas are protected as the land uses change in this area.

We understand that this proposal is a short plat, and no development actions are currently proposed. While no critical areas report is provided with the application materials, there are critical areas present on the subject parcels, including Fish and Wildlife Habitat Conservation Areas (FWHCA). Prior to new parcels being created as part of this project, the applicants should clearly demonstrate that they are not creating lots that will require variances and/or reasonable use exceptions from the critical areas requirements or other relevant sections of code when development is proposed.

There is an unnamed tributary that has previously been captured by the old Masterson Ditch. This watercourse appears to continue through the parcel and irrigated land in a straightened ditch like feature, before crossing Masterson Road and eventually enters the Teanaway River. This watercourse should be acknowledged and shown in the plans to ensure appropriate riparian management zones are applied to future land uses. This project area is also in a known elk winter range area.

To ensure new parcels created will not require variances from the critical areas ordinance or other County Codes when development is proposed, we recommend the following:

• Prior to approval of this application, complete a critical areas report that identifies all critical areas present within the project area and the required setbacks. Completing this report and assessment will result in the identification of areas where development would be allowed without the need for variances or reasonable use exceptions.

• If a critical areas report is not completed prior to approval, we recommend identifying the water course and the development envelope outside of critical areas and their setbacks to ensure future development will protect the unnamed stream.

We welcome the opportunity to work with local landowners and help them understand the wildlife and habitats around them. Thank you again for the opportunity to comment and please let me know if there are any questions or comments we can answer.

- A letter from a water purveyor stating that the purveyor has adequate water rights and will provide the necessary water for the new use;
- 2. An adequate water right for the proposed new use; or
- 3. A certificate of water budget neutrality from the Department of Ecology or other adequate interest in water rights from a water bank.

All applicants for land divisions shall also submit information on "proximate" parcels" held in "common ownership" as those terms are defined in WAC 173-539A-030 and otherwise demonstrate how the proposed new use will not violate RCW 90.44.050 as currently existing or hereafter amended.

Failure to obtain mitigation before commencement of an activity requiring mitigation shall be a code violation subject to enforcement under Title 18 KCC.

Final Plat Notes

The following notes shall be placed on the face of the plat:

- C-1 "Metering is required for all new uses of domestic water for residential well connections and usage must be recorded in a manner consistent with Kittitas County Code Chapter 13.35.027 and Ecology regulations."
- C-2 "The approval of this division of land provides no guarantee that use of water under the ground water exemption (RCW 90.44.050) for this plat or any portion thereof will not be subject to curtailment by the Department of Ecology or a court of law."
