Dear Resident:

The following is your new property address:

Gregory Weaver 482 Night Sky Drive Ronald, WA 98940

A property address serves a number of purposes:

First they support the Countywide "Enhanced 911" system. Anyone that calls 911 will have the address they are calling from displayed, for the 911 operator, at the County's Emergency Dispatch Center.

Second, your new address represents the physical location for your home. The addresses are established by measuring the distance from the beginning of your road to your driveway. The distance is measured in meters then rounded off and given an odd or even last digit, depending on which side of the road you are on.

Third, they may be used by the Post Office for mail delivery. The resident is responsible for contacting the local Post Office to set up mail delivery and box placement. If you only use a "P O Box" for your mail, this new address is to be used simply as a physical description of your home; there is no need to change your P O Box.

RESIDENCE ON A COMMON DRIVEWAY (Two address plates enclosed):

In some instances, there are several residences on a "common driveway". In which case, one of the address plates is installed on the house and the other will be installed on a post, at the beginning of the common driveway. The plates are then arranged from top to bottom, so that the top or first address plate indicates the address of the first access off the common driveway. The next plate indicates the next access point and so on.

RESIDENCE ON A PRIVATE OR COUNTY ROAD (One address plat enclosed):

Enclosed you'll find a blue and white address plate. Before you begin using your new address, please install this plate near the beginning of your driveway. Make sure the address plate is installed 3 to 5 feet from the ground, not more than 25 feet from the edge of the road, and not more than 10 feet from either side of the driveway so it can be seen from a vehicle, traveling from either direction on the road.

Washington State Law states: Address plates shall not be installed on any power or telephone pole.

The Public Works Dept. & Emergency response personal would like to stress residences not to install address plates on structures that do not meet the above criteria. Randomly placed address plates slow down response times for emergency personal to locate your address. Plates should be in clear visible view at all times.

Please confirm that the number on the plate matches the number given to you in this notice.
