Marc,

Thanks for the follow-up message. While DNR is the official keeper of stream typing for the state, they rely on several agency experts to give opinions regarding stream typing. We are one of those experts (in addition to the tribes and Dept of Ecology). The simplest way to resolve this issue may be to meet on site, I can look at these stream characteristics and determine if the stream is typed correctly and you can further show me the work planned around the creek and that will help to determine if there are any

issues there. To look at the stream and the plans, I would expect it to take a couple of hours or so. Also to type the stream we would need to walk downstream towards it's confluence with the other creek. Let me know if that would present any problems with landowners.

Can you list a time frame that you need to meet to resolve this and throw out some possible dates?

Also can you confirm that you will not be doing any replacement/repair or modifications to the stream culverts? That appeared to be the information presented in the SEPA materials, but wasn't entirely clear. I'm not familiar with those culverts, so would be good to look at them to ensure they are sized properly.
