SEPA ACTION DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

File: Ellsworth SEPA Checklist (SE-18-00003)

Description: A timber harvest will occur with the goal of increasing long-term productivity of

the majority of the harvest area. The operation will be thinning-from-below operation, designed to remove smaller suppressed, deformed, or trees quickly declining in vigor from the site. Resources that otherwise go to these trees will be available to retained trees post-harvest, resulting in increased growth and long term vigor for the stand. The area to be thinned is roughly 15 acres, with a harvest of approximately 50-60 MBF. This area will be maintained in forest land for the foreseeable future. A small area (less than 1 acre) will be clear-cut, and will be converted from forest land to non-forest land. A home site will be cleared and

developed in that area.
