Hi Jane,

I've attached a site plan that does a better job explaining the proposed work visually. Mr. Greear's application states that he is planning to "Widen driveway, increase size of building pad for shop, create building pad for house, create fire access tum around and firewise setback." Part of MDNS will include a dust control plan during the construction phase of the driveway & building pad work. There will likely be shared use of the driveway while it's being widened and the home is built. We would recommend talking with Mr. Greear about shared use of the driveway while construction is happening. I don't have a count on the number of trucks, but there is a KC ordinance for noise. The project will need to abide by the ordinance. Information relating to the ordinance can be found at Chapter 9.45 - Noise Control. https://www.co.kittitas.wa.us/boc/countycode/title09.aspx#Chapter\_9.45.

We are not expecting any mining on the property but would appreciate a heads up if you do see mining taking place.
