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Hi Zach,

This review is in response to the proposed setback variance application: VA-25-00003 Krebs. After reviewing the proposal, the CCT has no concerns regarding the variance's potential to affect cultural resources that will not be adequately addressed by other interested tribes or parties. We will note, however, that the project area does fall within an area determined by DAHP's predictive model to have a high likelihood of cultural material. If the proponent plans on doing any ground-disturbing work, we would generally recommend they have an IDP on hand.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed project on parcel(s) 815434 in Section 03, T. 19 N., Range 14 E., W.M.; Kittitas County.

Based on remote review of this parcel(s) it appears that some or all of the parcel(s) consist of forestland, and it will require a Forest Practices Application (FPA) from the DNR if merchantable timber is removed/harvested as part of the proposal and/or is being converted out of forest land (RCW 76.09 and WAC 222). The FPA would need to meet the requirements of the Forest Practices Act and its rules. It is our recommendation that the applicant meet with our local forest practices forester to discuss, they may call our Southeast Region office at (509) 925-8510 to schedule an appointment.

The Snoqualmie Tribe [Tribe] is a federally recognized sovereign Indian Tribe. We were signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliott of 1855; we reserved certain rights and privileges and ceded certain lands to the United States. As a signatory to the Treaty of Point Elliot, the Tribe specifically reserved among other things, the right to fish at usual and accustomed areas and the “privilege of hunting and gathering roots and berries on open and unclaimed lands” off-reservation throughout the modern-day state of Washington.

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment. Based on the information provided and our understanding of the project and its APE we have no substantive comments to offer at this time. However, please be aware that if the scope of the project or the parameters for defining the APE change, we reserve the right to modify our current position.
