

Notice of Application/Adoption
Bureau of Land Management, Wenatchee Resource Area
Shoreline Substantial Development Permit

Pursuant to RCW 43.21C and WAC 197-11-630 Kittitas County adopts the NEPA Environmental Assessment issued on June 9, 2006 by the Bureau of Land Management, Wenatchee Resource Area, for the boat access improvement project at Big Pines Recreation Area, Yakima River Canyon, Washington. The project is located at mile marker 9.5 along Highway 821 in the Yakima River Canyon and is located in a portion of Section 16, T. 15N. R. 19E., W.M. in Kittitas County. Map number 15-19-16000-0001.

The previously issued Environmental Assessment (EA #OR134-06-EA-01) has been reviewed and Kittitas County finds that the information documented therein meets the adopting agency's environmental review standards and needs for the proposal. Kittitas County Community Development Services has determined that the proposed application for improvement of the natural sand and gravel boat access to a hardened surface does not change the overall scope or purpose of the project or lead to any new significant adverse impacts. The Environmental Assessment will be contained as part of the record for Big Pines Boat Access file #SSDP-07-03.
