Public Hospital District No. 2, Kittitas County Proposition No. 1

Levy Lid Lift for Emergency Medical Services

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 2, Kittitas County, adopted Resolution No. 03-18-24-02, concerning a regular property levy for emergency medical care and services. If approved, this proposition would provide additional funds solely for emergency medical care and emergency medical services, including related personnel costs, training for such personnel, and related equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate for collection in 2025 of \$0.25/\$1,000 assessed value. The 2025 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for levies in subsequent years. Will the Public Hospital District No. 2, Kittitas County, be authorized to impose a PERMANENT regular property tax levy of 25 cents or less per thousand dollars (\$0.25/\$1,000) of assessed valuation to pay for emergency medical care and related services?
