ORDER SETTING NEW PAYMENT SCHEDULE

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

Defendant has requested and has been granted a new payment schedule. The defendant shall pay a minimum monthly payment of \$[] per month beginning [], and every month thereafter until legal financial obligation is paid. If for any reason Defendant is unable to make the minimum payment during any calendar month, Defendant must contact the Clerk's office to explain why Defendant was unable to make the payment and to make other payment arrangements.

It is the obligation of the Defendant to keep their residence and mailing address current with the Kittitas County Superior Court Clerk.

Administrative Pay or Appear review hearings may be set if the defendant fails to make their minimum monthly payment. Notice to the defendant will be provided by the Superior Court Clerk Collections Officer. **IF DEFENDANT DOES NOT APPEAR FOR COURT, OR A CURRENT ADDRESS IS NOT PROVIDED, A WARRANT MAY BE ISSUED.**

A collection fee of \$100.00 may be assessed if the defendant falls (3) three months past due on his/her legal financial obligation and an Order to Show Cause for failure to pay is entered. Failure to comply could result in imposition of up to 60 days jail time per violation.

If the Defendant is more than thirty days past due in monthly payments in an amount equal to or greater than the amount payable for one month, the Clerk of the Court may issue a notice of payroll deduction without further notice to the Defendant.
