With the start of the 2012-2013 school year, it's the time of year to distribute the "In Your Classroom" fact sheets again. The Kittitas County Public Health Department distributes these annually so that you have a quick reference regarding what your students are reporting from the Healthy Youth Survey. The fact sheet is from the most recent Healthy Youth Survey, conducted in October 2010. The categories selected for the fact sheets are areas that can put students at academic risk.

Research found that "the more health risks students had, the more likely it was that they were also at academic risk." The research also found that for every health risk addressed, students' academic success increased. *

Please review the attached "In Your Classroom" fact sheet; addressing even one risk factor in a student will increase the student's ability to learn.

-Access to Baby and Child Dentistry






