<p><b>Establish outdoor education programs coordinator</b> who will use our 80-acre site to promote physical activity and enhance mental well-being. Their role will be to develop programming at the elementary level to increase outdoor hands-on learning. In addition, they will support teachers in developing the skills necessary to increase activities that promote an active lifestyle (x-country skiing, alpine skiing, hiking, mountain biking) to increase outdoor learning experiences in all four schools. The coordinator will help conduct professional development to increase teacher and staff comfort with outdoor experiential learning techniques.</p>	<p>We have not been able to fund this position. We needed the funding to support the staff we had in the equipment they needed, but we have not resolved a coordinator. I do most of it, and we had someone in year one grant, but they had to expand to full time employment so we do not have this during this grant cycle.</p>		

<p><b>Update PE and health programs with new curriculum and training</b> to enhance student engagement and physical health. Introduce more relevant programming and courses as well as field trip experiences. Behaviors are high post pandemic, and a portion of our focus in this category is to add additional hours of behavior specialist to assist with outdoor education in improving student behavior.</p>	<p>We just registered for next year, and we updated course titles and options in PE and we are excited about seeing more students active in non-traditional PE programs.</p>		
<p><b>Implement strategies to decrease cell phone usage</b> by launching awareness campaigns, organizing structured offline activities, and providing equipment for device storage.</p>	<p>It's not perfect, but we are better than where we started!</p>		
<p><b>Establish new after-school programs</b> focused on prevention and wellness.</p>	<p>We are currently negotiating a few new clubs and stipends for winter. Girls and boys are considering expansion of their programming. We did add a MS small</p>		

<p><b>Provide training for staff</b> to effectively implement and manage new strategies aimed at reducing mental health challenges and preventing substance abuse. One key aspect of this proposal is updating current District policy and professional development around substance abuse. We would use our Community Coalition team to use industry experts to update our current policy on drug, alcohol, and tobacco policies with training to reduce use, and updating supports for students with infractions.</p>	<p>We have exhausted this funding, but see great evidence of the work around SEL, Mental health, and how we support all students from the PD.</p>		
<p><b>Directly contracting for mental health, nursing, and substance abuse professionals</b> to increase services in comprehensive mental health services, suicide prevention, immunization clinics, increased staff development on how to reduce substance abuse and support increasing efforts to reduce mental health barriers in schools.</p>	<p>We used these funds to address the costs of full time mental health counselor, and two RN nurses.</p>
