Basis for Project: Fish Barrier Removal/Culvert Replacement

Construction: 2020

Project Description: Yakima Basin Fish and Wildlife Recovery Board is advocating that fish be brought back into creeks by identifying barriers and working with local entities to fix them. The first crossing scheduled for replacement is Coleman Creek under Vantage Hwy. Work included installing a temporary stream bypass, removing one metal culvert and one concrete culvert followed by installation of a 26' X 52' precast structure. Concrete barrier and guardrail were installed to improve roadway shoulders to comply with current design standards.

Status: **Construction completed October 21st, 2020**

Contractor: Belsaas & Smith Construction

Traffic Impacts: Construction was scheduled from mid September through October 2020. **A full road closure took place from September 18th through October 1st.** A detour route was in place to redirect traffic during this closure.
