





KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas the County of Kittitas in the State of Washington is desirous of changing the location of the county road known as the "Ellensburg and Cle Flum Lake Road No. 12." in section 34, township 20 north, range 16 E. W. M. in said county, and for the purpose of making such change is desirous of acquiring a right of way through land owned by the Cascade Lumber Company, and, whereas there are certain irrigating ditches and flumes running along the west side of the present line of said county road at the place where said change of location is to be made, which said ditches and flumes have heretofore broken and allowed water to wash soil and gravel across said road onto the land of the said Cascade Lumber Company;

Now, in consideration of the undertaking and agreement of the County of Kittitas to protect said Cascade Lumber Company from all damages to its land lying between the line of said proposed changed location, hereinafter described, and the Teanaway River from overflow or wash from said irrigating ditches and flumes, the said Cascade Lumber Company does hereby grant to the County of Kittitas an easement for county road purposes over and across a tract of land described as follows, to-wit: a strip of land 40 feet in width being 20 feet on each side of a line described as follows: beginning at a point 217 feet south of the North quarter corner of Section 34, Township 20 North, of Range 16 E. 


