Gentlemen:-

We, the undersigned, citizens and taxpayers of Kittitas County, Washington, realizing the importance, and, as a business transaction, the necessity of a suitable road being constructed from Salmon-la-sac to Bur~~ks~~ Mining District, again petition your Honorable body to take such action in the matter as you may deem necessary to the immediate construction of said road.

We wish also to call ~~the~~ attention of your honorable body to the fact that owing to the shortness of the season it is necessary to expedite matters relating thereto, also to the fact that the late Chariman of your honorable board, John Brown, on divers occasions expressed himself as strongly in favor of such an enterprise, after making a thorough examination. Finally in view of the advantage to be gained to the county in the way of trade being directed to Kittitas County. Inasmuch as the west end of the County have already built one bridge across the Clealum River, ~~which~~, through lack of action of your honorable body, was allowed to be washed out by high water, and constructed fifteen miles of trail, and have at the present time under construction a tram way bridge, and have kept the Fish Lake road from time to time in repair, ~~though~~<sup>by</sup> private subscription and in consideration of the comparison of the amount of taxes levied and paid, and the amount of money expended, in consideration thereof we do hereby once more urge upon your honorable body to recognize this appeal by a speedy compliance to the aforeaaid request.

The land over which the proposed road passes is all unencumbered.

Third:

In our opinion the Road should be established Sixty feet in width.

Fourth:

The probable cost of the construction of the road, including all necessary bridges and culverts and all clearing, grubbing and grading will be \$3200.00.

Fifth:

In our opinion the road is a necessity and should be established and opened.

Sixth:

This road leads to a mining district the prospects of which are nearly all situated in King County. There are no agricultural settlers along the route. The above estimate would only make a very ordinary wagon road.

A greater portion of this road would be side hill grades consisting of loose and solid rock.

## Viewers' Report

SECTION 7. When the view and the survey of the proposed road is completed the viewers must report in writing to the Board of County Commissioners:

1. The terminal points, course and length of the road as laid out and surveyed.
2. The accurate description of each tract of land over which such road passes, with the name and place of residence or address of the owners, lessees, and incumbancers of each of said tracts, and the quantity or area of land to be taken from each tract for such road.
3. The estimated damages to each tract of land over which such road has been so laid out and surveyed.
4. The names of the persons interested in said lands who consent to the establishment of the road and waive all claims to damages.
5. The names of persons interested in said lands who refuse their consent and the amount of damages claimed by each.
6. Whether such road should be of a different width from that specified in the petition, and if so, giving the width recommended by the viewers
7. The probable cost of the construction of the road, including all necessary bridges and culverts, and all clearing, grubbing, and grading.
8. The opinion of the viewers as to the necessity for the road, and their decision as to whether the same ought to be established and opened or not.
9. Such other facts, matters and things as such viewers may deem of importance to be known by the Board of County Commissioners.
10. They may, in their discretion or by order of the Board, report upon the feasibility and cost of any other route than the one petitioned for, which would subserve the same purpose.

SECTION 8. Said viewers shall file with their report the written consent and waivers of damages by persons interested in the lands affected by the establishment of said road, and the claims of damages, procured as provided in this act.
