This decision is based on our finding that: The issue before the Board is the assessed value of land/improvements. A hearing was held on April 21, 2016. Those present: Chairman Ann Shaw, Jennifer Hoyt, Reta Hutchinson, Clerk Debbie Myers, Appraiser Anthony Clayton, and Appellant Del Holter. Appellant Del Holter said the land had remained the same value as last year and he was happy with that, but he disagreed with the improvements increase of \$11,000 in one year. He discussed sales in the Liberty area. Appraiser Anthony Clayton said the house in the Liberty area is valued based on comparables sales like we usally do, based on properties characteristics.					
There was discussion on homes quality, age, and depreciation, old buildings in the Liberty area, mines, oil & mineral rights.					
Pursuant to RCW 84.40.0301, the value placed on the property by the Assessor is presumed to be correct, and can only be overcome by clear cogent and convincing evidence. This means the appellant is required to provide enough information to convince this Board that it is highly probable the assessed value is incorrect.					
The Board has determined that the land value remain at \$48,600 and the improvement value \$153,830 for a total value of \$202,430. The comparable sales in the Liberty area support the adjustment made by the Board. The Board of Equalization voted 3-0 to overrule the Assessor's valuation.
