### **Emergency Secondary Notification Email to Text Summary**

IT performed a test of the Emergency Secondary Notification Email to Text system on 03/16/2017. Of the 88 recipients, 85 succeeded, 1 failed, and 2 were out of office and have not reported.

### **City of Cle Elum Fiber Network Update**

Doug Fessler, Network Administrator, has been working with the City of Cle Elum to build a computer network connecting their facilities. The work is proceeding and is funded by the City of Cle Elum.
