HR Director Young summarized a request for multi-lingual staff of Juvenile Probation to receive an interpreter stipend for their services in court. Juvenile Court Administrator Mankus explained that in recent years there has been an increased need for these services. The stipend would mirror that of the Lower District Court. Director Young clarified that at this time they are seeking approval to discuss the idea of the interpreter stipend with the union, and will come back to the Board for final approval. Commissioners Wright and Wachsmith verbalized support of pursuing the stipend with the union. Director Young will move forward with contacting the union.
